A certificate of ARI-certified performance must be submitted. ALL homeowners must complete a rebate request form and provide proof of purchase to receive any 2010 Daviess-Martin County REMC rebate. Deadline to apply for 2010 Rebate Program is Dec. 31, 2010. **ALL homeowners and future homeowners receiving Daviess-Martin County REMC rebates agree to the future installation of load control devices on these rebated appliances to allow Daviess-Martin County REMC the opportunity to engage in future demand management load control procedures.**
