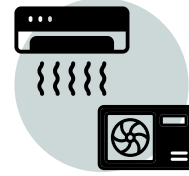


Residential HVAC

To Qualify:

- Must be installed in a home served by Daviess-Martin County REMC.
- Heat pumps are for whole-home installations only with exception of the Mini-Split Heat Pumps.
- SEER2 & HSPF2 ratings must be obtained from the AHRI certificate.
- An AHRI Certificate must accompany the application and invoice to be qualified. You can obtain the AHRI certificate from your contractor or from the manufacturer.
- Limit of two (2) rebates allowed per primary residence per useful life of rebated equipment.
- Submission for rebates must be within 90 days of installation in the same calendar year.
- Incentive amount can not exceed 50% of equipment cost.
- Please review the complete list of terms and conditions following the application.

Residential HVAC Terms & Conditions



Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a current Daviess-Martin County REMC residential member-consumer.
- Equipment installations or upgrades must be in a residential single-family home served by Daviess-Martin County REMC.
- Applicant must be a year-round occupant of the home where the equipment is installed.
- Program eligibility includes prior participation in rebate programs, with incentive and measure caps specific for each program. Applications in excess of program caps will not be processed.

HVAC Rebate Program Requirements

- The HVAC rebate is designed for installation or upgrades of air source heat pumps, geothermal heat pumps, ductless mini-split heat pumps or dual fuel heat pumps.
- Rebates for HVAC equipment are for whole-home installations only unless otherwise stated.
- All homeowners must provide an AHRI (Air conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute) Certificate. This information is obtained from the installing heating and cooling contractor.
- Submission for HVAC rebate must include application, AHRI Certificate and itemized receipt or invoice. Applicant understands no rebate will be given if applicant and/or applicant's contractor fails to provide required documentation.
- No rebate will be awarded based on HVAC dealer bid specifications, promotional materials of dealer, manufacturer or any source other than AHRI Certificate.
- Limit of two rebates per primary residence, per the deemed useful life of rebated equipment as determined by Hoosier Energy.

Program Parameters

- All rebated equipment must be new. Used or rebuilt equipment is not eligible for an incentive.
- Rebated equipment must meet all requirements from the manufacturer's warranty.
- Rebated equipment must meet the technical specifications listed in the application form.
- Applicant agrees to purchase power from Daviess-Martin County REMC for a period not less than the deemed measured useful life of rebated equipment. Should the applicant receive 100% of their power from any source other than Daviess-Martin County REMC, including generation owned by the customer before the end of the equipment's deemed useful life, the applicant agrees to refund the full amount of the rebate to Daviess-Martin County REMC.
- Hoosier Energy maintains full discretion over the rebate and reserves the right to modify the program at any time.

Application Procedures and Deadlines

- Applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis while funds are available.
- Submission for rebates must be within 90 days of installation in the same calendar year.
- Applications become the property of Daviess-Martin County REMC and will not be returned. Please keep a copy for your records.

Right to Confirm Installation

- Pre-install inspection: Daviess-Martin County REMC reserves the right to inspect the program participant's premises to verify that equipment meeting program qualifications exists prior to providing an incentive. The program participant agrees to provide reasonable access to the premises for such purposes.
- Post-install inspection: Daviess-Martin County REMC reserves the right to inspect the program participant's premises to verify that equipment matching the information provided on the program application has been placed in service at that location. The program participant agrees to provide reasonable access to the premises for such purposes.

- Post-inspection: The program participant will have 30 days from the request date to submit any additional information requested by Daviess-Martin County REMC. Failure to submit requested information may result in application rejection.
- If any requested inspection finds the program participant or the program participant's contractor did not comply with program rules and standards, any incentive received must be returned to Daviess-Martin County REMC within 60 days of notice of such inspection.
- Daviess-Martin County REMC reserves the right to conduct an additional post-install inspection for program portfolio evaluation, measurement and verification (EM&V) purposes. Incentives received will not be affected by the results of this inspection.

Incentive Payments

- Daviess-Martin County REMC reserves the right to approve or deny incentive.
- The incentive payment cannot exceed 50% of the total equipment cost. Installation, taxes and fees cannot be included in the equipment cost.
- Rebates may take up to six weeks from receipt of the application by Daviess-Martin County REMC to process.
- Approved rebates will be returned to the applicant in the form of a bill credit or a check by mail, via the U.S. Postal Service. Application approval is not a guarantee of incentive payment.
- Daviess-Martin County REMC reserves the right to withhold payment for products that do not meet the program requirements as determined within its sole discretion.
- Daviess-Martin County REMC is not liable for incentives promised to members as a result of a contractor misrepresenting or not verifying the rules of the program. Only Daviess-Martin County REMC has the right to approve an application and the incentives.
- Incentives are paid as a one-time, one-program offer and cannot be combined with incentive payments, rebates or discount programs from other utility providers.

Logo Use

- Program applicants and program participants may not use any member cooperative or Hoosier Energy logo or name without prior express written permission.
